CLEVELAND-- Trinity Cathedral was awarded two national awards, called Polly Bond Awards, at the April annual meeting of the Episcopal Communicators in Salt Lake City.

The Polly Bond Awards, named after a well-beloved director of communications in the Diocese of Ohio, were established in the mid-1970s by Episcopal Communicators to acknowledge excellence and achievement in the ministry of church communication.
